

VEHICLE CROSSING POINTS – VIRGIN MONEY LONDON MARATHON / 23 APRIL

Road closures will be in place on the event route from 07:00 on Sunday 23 April.

Vehicle crossing points will manage vehicles into and out of affected areas from 07:00. Vehicles will be facilitated across the event route by stewards at identified crossing points only. Vehicles CANNOT travel along the closed roads/event route.

Listed below are the vehicle crossing points. Please note that once a crossing point is closed, drivers will NOT be permitted to cross the route. This may be earlier than the times stated if directed by stewards or the Marathon Forward Command Vehicle.

This 'total closure' will remain in force until the London Marathon rear command vehicle passes or when directed by stewards.

VEHICLE CROSSING POINTS:

Charlton & Woolwich

- › Charlton Road / Victoria Way / Marlborough Lane – crossing over Charlton Road (north and south) – until 08:45.
- › Shooters Hill Rd / Kenya Road / Weyman Road – crossing over Shooters Hill Road (north and south) – until 08:45.
- › Ha-Ha Road / Stadium Road / Repository Road – crossing over Ha-Ha Road (north and south) – until 08:45.
- › Artillery Place / Repository Road / Frances Street – crossing over Artillery Place (north and south) – until 08:45.
- › Woolwich Road / Frances Street / Leda Road – crossing over Woolwich Road (north and south) – until 08:45.
- › Woolwich Road / Anchor & Hope Lane / Charlton Church Lane – crossing over Woolwich Road (north and south) – until 09:00.

Greenwich & Blackwall Tunnel

- › Tunnel Avenue / Woolwich Road / A102 Northbound – residents living in the area between Blackwall Lane and Tunnel Avenue on the north side of the event route, will be able to travel south on Tunnel Avenue then eastbound on Woolwich Road to access A102 Blackwall Tunnel northbound. Residents wishing to travel south can leave at the next exit and re-join the southbound A102. This is available all day.
- › Trafalgar Road / Blackwall Lane / Vanbrugh Hill – crossing over Trafalgar Road (north and south) – until 09:05.
- › Creek Road / Norman Road / Norway Street – crossing over Creek Road (north and south) – until 09:15.
- › Creek Road / Glaisher Street / Gonson Street / Creekside – crossing over Creek Road (north and south) – until 09:15.

Deptford & Rotherhithe

- › Creek Road / Deptford High Street / Watergate Street – crossing over Creek Road (north and south) – until 09:15.
- › Evelyn Street / Abinger Grove / Grove Street / Princes Street – crossing over Evelyn Street (north and south), allowing Pepys Estate and Plough Way area in and out – until 09:20.
- › Lower Road / Plough Way – crossing over Lower Road (south only) – until 09:20
- › Redriff Road / Deal Porters Way / Worgan Street – crossing over Redriff Road, allowing Osprey Estate and Worgan Street residents in and out – until 09:30.
- › Salter Road / Rotherhithe Street / Lagado Mews – crossing Salter Road (north and south), allowing Rotherhithe Street residents in and out – until 09:30.
- › Brunel Road / Cannon Beck Road – crossing Brunel Road (east and west) – until 09:30.

Bermondsey

- › Jamaica Road / West Lane / Southwark Park Road – crossing Jamaica Road (north and south) – until 09:30.
- › Jamaica Road / Bevington Street / St James's Road – crossing Jamaica Road (north and South) – until 09:30.
- › Jamaica Road / Dockhead / Mill Street – crossing Jamaica Road (north and south) – until 09:30.
- › Jamaica Road / Shad Thames / Tanner Street – crossing Jamaica Road – until 09:30.

Wapping & Shadwell

- › The Highway / Glamis Road – controlled by London Marathon marshals – crossing The Highway (north and south) – until 09:50 then again from approx 14:30.

INFO

Please note that all reopening times are approximate. Stewards will open vehicle crossing points when it is safe to do so. Crossing points may close earlier if directed by stewards or the London Marathon forward command vehicle.
